



Meal Service for Virtual Learners

Healthy and delicious grab and go school meals will be available to all enrolled BISD virtual learning students. The packaged meals will be distributed in a drive -thru fashion at the Borger High School teacher parking lot cafeteria door entrance. Breakfast meals will be available 8:00-8:15. Lunch meals will be available 11:45 - noon.

Compliance for Grab and Go Meal Pickup

All parents/guardians must provide their student's name and student's ID number when picking up meals whether the student is present or not. Students are not required to be present for a meal pickup, but they must be enrolled in Borger ISD.

Meal Pricing and Payment Options

Meals will no longer be free of charge for all students, as provided during the spring remote learning and summer feeding program. Student free and reduced priced meals are available for qualifying students. All meals will be priced based on the student's current eligibility status. Parents/guardians are responsible for all student balances. Online payments will be accepted through the <https://www.myschoolbucks.com>. Cash and checks will also be accepted.

Federal Meal Application

Student eligibility status from the 2019-2020 school year will roll over for the first 30 operating days of school or until a new application has been processed. If you would like to complete a household application for free and reduced-price meals, you may pick up an application at any BISD campus office, the administration building or refer to the Child Nutrition Department on the website. Allow 10 business days for application processing.

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
